## Firefox tips and tricks

This page documents how to do some non-obvious things with Firefox<sup>1</sup>. Unless noted otherwise, the instructions apply to Firefox 3.5.

## 1 Clearing your private data

If you want to clear your history and your HTTP-authenticated<sup>2</sup> sessions, follow those steps:

- 1. Click Menu -> Edit -> Preference
- 2. Go to Privacy -> Clear all current history
- 3. Select your time range and click on Clear now

## 2 Getting a warning on quit

Since you can easily quit firefox by mistake, e.g by typing Ctrl-q instead of Ctrl-w<sup>3</sup>, getting a warning asking whether we are sure is nice. Unfortunately a bug in firefox  $3.5^4$  disables this behavior under some circumstances

I haven't found a fix that worked for me: even installing Tab Mix Plus<sup>5</sup> could not do anything when I did a Ctrl-q.

## 3 Backing up your configuration

To backup my firefox configuration and extensions, I use an extension called  ${\rm FEBE}^6$  .
